UPCOMNG TRAINING

The level of training you need very much depends on your role and an **amended framework** was adopted by General Assembly in July 2025. The full framework can be found here If you are unsure of what level you require, please speak to Lucinda.

The Foundation course is designed to expand your knowledge and understanding of why safeguarding and good practice are so important to all of us in the URC. This is an online course and the link to access it can be here: **Foundation course online**

An Introduction Module for safeguarding in the URC is designed for those who are asked to do Foundation level training but who already come with a background in safeguarding and have completed training within a professional organisation in the previous three years. This course doesn't look at the signs and symptoms of abuse and so if you need information on this you will need to do Foundation level training (above).
